On June 23rd, the City hosted a neighborhood meeting for Downtown residents at the Edmonds Waterfront Center to discuss public space activation opportunities in the Downtown area. This initiative is part of a citywide effort called **Reimagining Neighborhoods and Streets**, to consider how we can optimize our streets and public spaces to support community development and local businesses.

Based on meeting input, participants voted for a **community Yardfest - a temporary "pavement-to-yard"** on Main Street between 5th and 6th Ave. If the majority of survey respondents support this idea, the City will work with a core group to implement it.

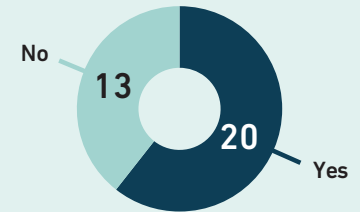

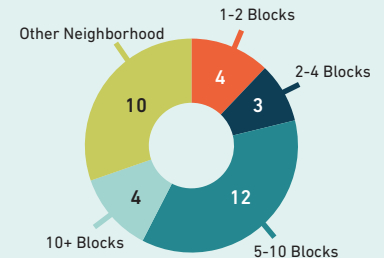
What's your favorite activation strategy?
