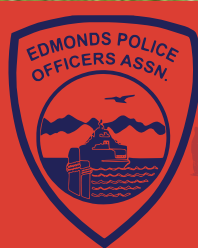

Stop \$3.6 million in cuts to our police.

Without Prop 1, Edmonds will be forced to cut public safety spending, reducing our police to 0.84 officers per 1,000 residents: well below national (2.4/1000) and state (1.4/1000) averages. **That's why Prop 1 is endorsed by Edmonds Police.**



Stop \$1.8 million in cuts to our parks.

Without Prop 1, Edmonds will be forced to close Yost Pool, the spray pad at City Park, and programs at Frances Anderson that working families depend on.

Prop 1 will cost the median household:

\$2.14/day

(less than 1% of the Edmonds median household income.)

Seniors and those with disabilities earning less than \$75,000 a year are exempt.
